6 ENVIRONMENT EFFECTS



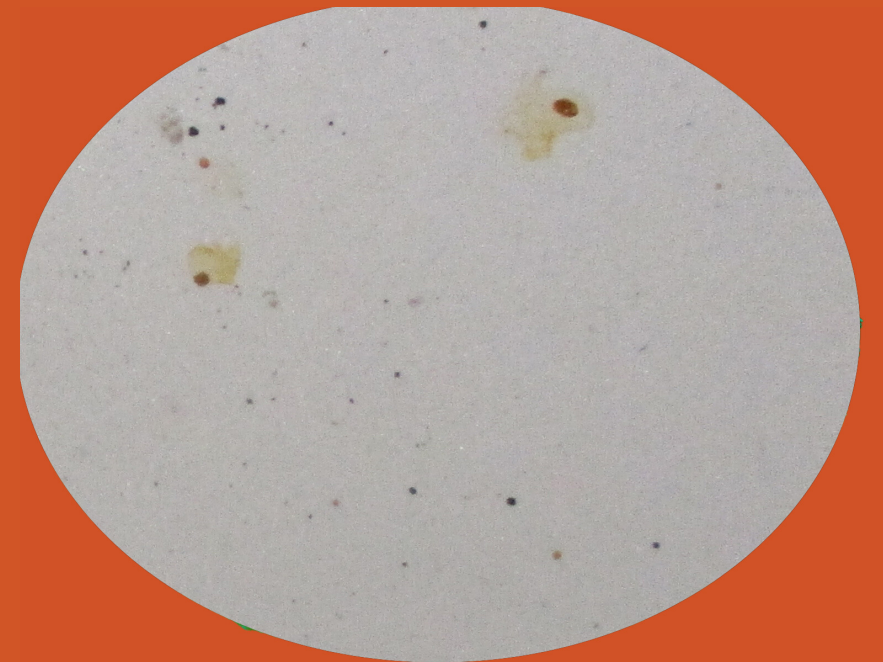
BIRD DROPPINGS

Are highly acidic and may cause discolouration or bubbling of paint.
Solution: Wash immediately, use Wash & Gloss to remove contaminants.



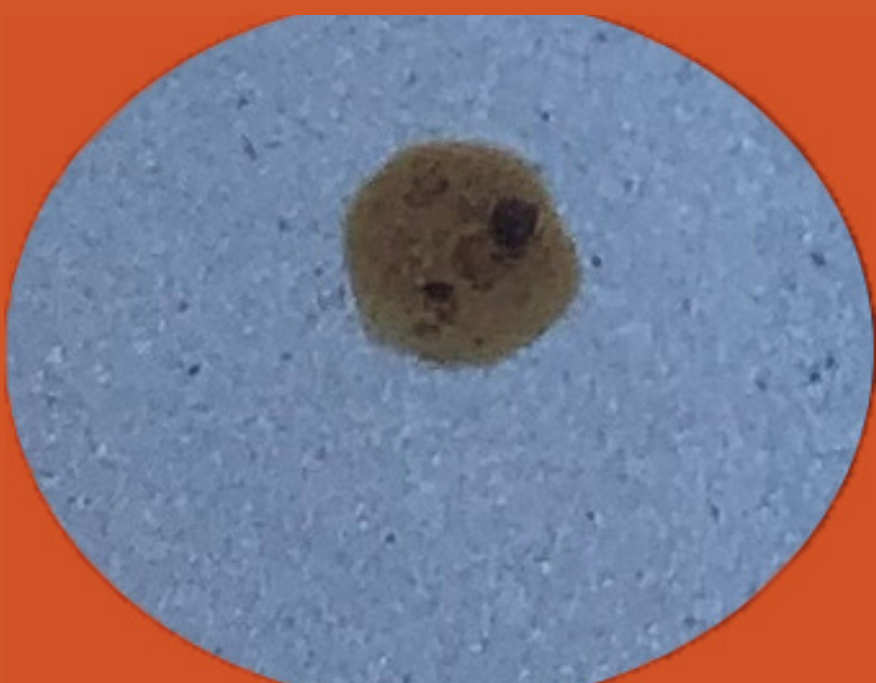
STONE CHIPS

Tiny, yet noticeable and almost impossible to avoid. Most common on front end of car. May cause effect to paint.
Solution: Brush touch or repair/replace & paint panel.



TREE SAP

Appears in thread or droplet like deposits. The resin chemical could potentially etch deep in paintwork.
Solution: Remove with soapy water and polish.



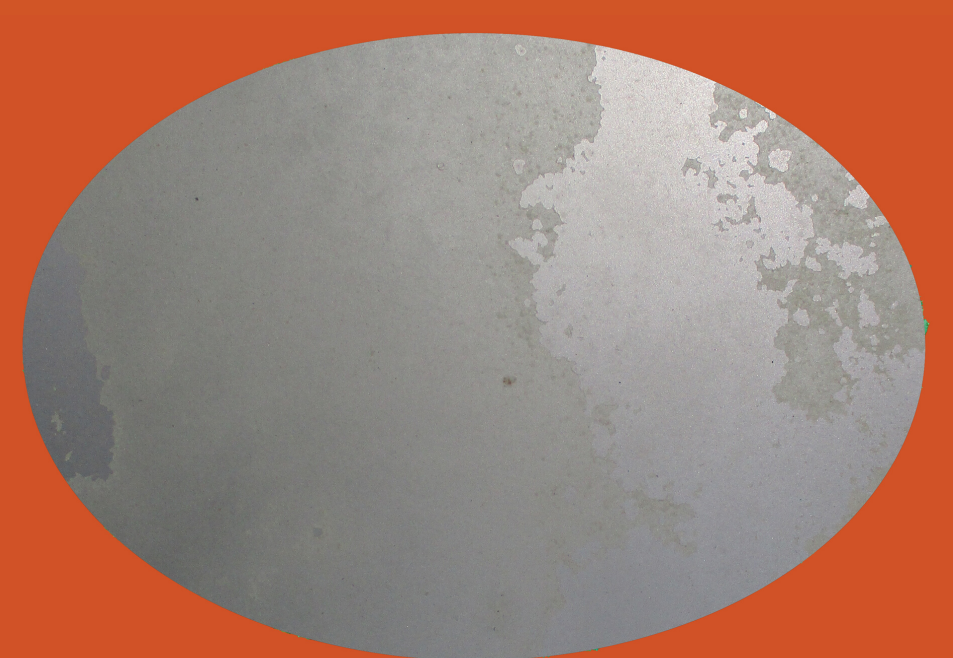
BUG MARKS

Faint yellow marks. Top layer of paint film potential to discolour. Easiest effect to resolve.
Solution: Remove immediately with soapy water.



INDUSTRIAL FALLOUT

Most dreaded effect. Rust particles sit on top paint layer film. As the ability to cause corrosion.
Solution: Use a clay cloth to remove.



FADING COLOUR

UV radiation and weather exposure overtime are major contributors.
Solution: Little prevention remedies other than re-painting effected panels.
